

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TEAM /CLUB COMPETITION

101KM TEAM COMPETITION

- Open to all categories of riders cycling in the 101km distance.
- Members need not be part of the same club, BUT an extra bonus cash prize will be presented to the first bona fide club. (Bona fide meaning that each member is registered with CSA as part of that specific club) -
- The “Team” must cover a total distance of 505 km i.e. 5members x 101km=505km,
- The “Team” will be made up of the 5 riders with each member contributing to the final accumulated time. The winning team has the lowest accumulated time over the 505km distance or fastest average speed.
- Note at least two members of the team must compete under/in the category “open seeded” in the 101km distance (i.e. not be part of the racing veteran/junior/elite et al racing licensed categories)
- At least one female must be in the team; this could include being part of a mixed tandem. Yes of course more females can make up the team.
- Only one tandem pairing is allowed to be part of the team, BUT, only one rider’s time of the teams tandem will count towards final overall time.
- Only one racing elite/under 23 rider allowed to be part of the team.
- Riders should enter individually into their event as per normal, and then the team must be entered separately by the Captain listing the riders under a dedicated name for e.g. “THE A TEAM “and stating if it is a registered club team or a made up team. The team entry will cost an extra R100 per team to cover admin fees. Each team entry will be “scrutinized “ to ensure the entry requirements are met and valid. It may be easier for the Captain to enter his/her team on a “separate manual hardcopy” entry form which can be downloaded from the website, and then faxed/mailed to race headquarters.
- Each rider must wear his/her timing chip
- The team must be entered by no later then by Saturday 09 Oct 12 noon. NOTE “last minute” substitutions for eg a rider gets sick before the event can only be made via an official written request stating all details at least 30 min before starting time of Sunday 10 Oct and presented to the “Time keepers”
- PRIZE MONIES 1ST = R2000, 2nd = R1500, 3rd = R1000. The first bona fide club team will receive R1500. (Total =R6000.00)
- At least 5 teams must enter for the prize’s to be awarded.

72KM DISTANCE

- Open to all categories of riders in 72km

- 4 riders per team. Teams can be made up, or be part of a club (extra prize for bona fide club). Winner is the lowest accumulated time of 4 riders over 288km.
- Only one male rider from licensed under 16 section allowed. All females allowed.
- Riders should enter individually into their event as per normal, and then the team must be entered separately by the Captain listing the riders under a dedicated name for e.g. "THE A TEAM" and stating if it is a registered club team or a made up team. The team entry will cost an extra R100 per team to cover admin fees. Each team entry will be "scrutinized" to ensure the entry requirements are met and valid. It may be easier for the Captain to enter his/her team on a "separate manual hardcopy" entry form which can be downloaded from the website, and then faxed/mailed to race headquarters.
- Only one member of a tandem pairing to count. Only one tandem allowed per team
- 1st prize R1000, 2nd R500 1ST Club R500 (Total =R2000)
- Entry fee R50 per team
- At least 5 teams to enter for all prizes to be awarded
- Riders to enter individually, and then the Captain to enter the team listing the names.
- All riders to wear timing chip

54 KM DISTANCE

- Open to all categories of riders
- 4 riders per team
- Only 1 tandem allowed per team. Only 1 member of the tandem to count towards overall time.
- Exploitation of the competition by "established racing cyclists" will be judged accordingly, the judge's decision will be final.
- Riders should enter individually into their event as per normal, and then the team must be entered separately by the Captain listing the riders under a dedicated name for e.g. "THE A TEAM" and stating if it is a registered club team or a made up team. Each team entry will be "scrutinized" to ensure the entry requirements are met and valid. It may be easier for the Captain to enter his/her team on a "separate manual hardcopy"

entry form which can be downloaded from the website, and then faxed/emailed to race headquarters.

- Entry fee R50 per team
- 1st prize R1000.
- At least 3 teams to enter for prize to be awarded
- Riders to enter individually and then the Captain to enter the team listing the names.
- All riders to wear timing chip
